#1 FORUM POST ON THE FOUR QUESTIONS

Dear D____,

Thanks for your response. I can see that our understanding is still pretty far apart. When you get time, I would like to discuss your answers and maybe you can share with me why you believe as you do. But I certainly understand that you are limited on time right now so just let me know when and if you want to have a detailed discussion.

Since I asked you for the answers on these questions, it is probably only fair that I answer the questions as well. Here are my short answers:

Do you believe that mankind has a "free will" to choose or reject Christ?

Mankind does not have a "free will". God's "will" rules supreme over our "will". Nothing in God's creation ever acts outside of God's "will". Even when we sin, it is because it was God's "will" for it to happen:

Job 34:12 Yea, surely God will not do wickedly, neither will the Almighty pervert judgment.

Luke 12:49 "I came to send fire on the earth, and how I wish it were already kindled!
