The bear does not represent Russia.

Here is what Paul says about how to understand spirit words (John 6:63):

1Cor 2:13 These things we also speak, not in words which man's wisdom teaches but which the Holy Spirit teaches, comparing spiritual things (words) with spiritual (words).

When we compare the spirit word "bear" with how it is used elsewhere in scripture, we can discern that the spirit word "bear" represents Satan. My comments are in **blue**.

1Sam 17: And David said unto Saul, Thy servant kept his father's sheep, and there came a lion, and a <u>bear</u>, and took a lamb out of the flock (when a carnal believer/babe becomes apostate):

1Sam 17:36 Thy servant (the converted Elect) slew both the lion and the <u>bear</u>: and this uncircumcised Philistine (represents the Old Man) shall be as one of them, seeing he hath defied the armies (the Elect) of the living God.

Prov 28:15 As a roaring lion, and a <u>ranging bear</u>; so is a wicked ruler over the poor people (spiritually poor/carnal babes).

In the verse below, Satan (as a bear) is shown to be raised up on one side eating three ribs:

Dan 7:5 And behold another beast, a second, like to a bear, and it <u>raised up itself on one</u> <u>side</u> (represents "works"), and it had <u>three ribs in the mouth</u> of it between the teeth of it: and they said thus unto it, Arise, devour much flesh (called out believers/babes).

The number <u>three</u> is a symbol which represents a spiritual process and the symbol "<u>ribs</u>" represents mankind's carnal and marred spirit. It is through mankind's carnal spirit (the ribs) that Satan "devours much flesh". From this spiritual process of Satan consuming all new believers through their carnality, a "worse than the first" (**Mat 12:43-45**) child of the Devil is made.

The scriptures below teach how Satan as a bear devours the church via the spirit of anti-Christ.

Acts 20:29 For I know this, that after my departing shall grievous wolves (ministers of Satan who have the spirit of anti-Christ) enter in among you, not sparing the flock (100%).

Isa 28:11 For with stammering lips and <u>another language</u> (spiritual language) will he speak to this people. 12 But the word of the LORD was unto them precept upon precept, precept upon precept; line upon line, line upon line; here a little, and there a little; that they (babes who draw milk) might go, and <u>fall backward, and be broken, and snared, and taken</u> (by Satan).

Mat 12:43 When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walketh through dry places, seeking rest, and findeth none. 44 Then he saith, I will return into my house from whence I

came out; and when he is come, he findeth it empty, swept, and garnished. 45 Then goeth he, and <u>taketh with himself SEVEN other spirits more wicked than himself</u>, and they enter in and dwell there: and the <u>last state of that man is worse than the first</u>. Even so shall it be also unto this wicked generation.

In Mat 12:43-45, the spiritual symbol of an unclean spirit represents a spirit which teaches Satan's false truth through lies and deceptions.

Since a new believer remains <u>spiritually blind</u> (Mark 8:21-25) after receiving the Early Rain of the Spirit, they cannot replace their worldly false beliefs with the truth of Christ. ONE unclean spirit leaves but comes back with SEVEN more. The number "seven" represents perfection. In this case, the number seven represents the perfection of Satan's lies/deceptions which come to a believer by the indwelling of the spirit of anti-Christ. Now, instead of ONE unclean spirit within the believer, they now have EIGHT. The number eight is a spiritual symbol which represents a <u>new spiritual condition</u>. In this case, the new spiritual condition is <u>worse than the first</u> (a man of sin).

Because all new believers begin following Christ as "babes", all new believers will "**fall backward, and be broken, and snared, and taken**" by Satan and will enter the apostate church. Because all new believers become apostate, when Christ returns to the ones who have been chosen (the Elect), Christ will find them in this fallen away condition. To restore the Elect believer, Christ will pour out the Latter Rain of the Spirit and heal their spiritual blindness. With their blindness healed, they will see the Abomination of Desolation which previously occurred when the spirit of anti-Christ entered them. This will cause the Elect believer to come out from Satan's deceptions.

The two scriptures below apply to this time:

Mat 24:15 When ye therefore shall see the abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, stand in the holy place, (whoso readeth, let him understand:) 16 Then let them which be in Judaea flee into the mountains (because judgment is about to fall):

2Thes 2:8 And then shall that Wicked (an apostate believer/man of sin) be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming:

Christ's judgment of the Elect believer is described in the verses below:

Mat 24:38 For as in the days that were before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark, 39 And knew not until the flood came, and took them all away; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be. 40 Then shall two be in the field; the one shall be taken, and the other left. 41 Two women shall be grinding at the mill; the one shall be taken, and the other left.

Here is how to understand verses 40 & 41:

40 Then shall two (Holy Spirit & spirit of anti-Christ/child of God & man of sin) be in the field (represents one believer who is "working"); the one shall be taken (spirit of anti-Christ/man of sin), and the other left (Holy Spirit/child of God). 41 Two women (Great Harlot & new spiritual nature of the Holy Spirit) shall be grinding at the mill (represents one believer who is "working" making leavened bread); the one shall be taken (Great Harlot), and the other left (new spiritual nature of the Holy Spirit).

The judgment event described above completes the <u>conversion process</u> which changes the old vessel (child of the Devil) into the new vessel (child of God).

How Noah's flood applies:

Noah's flood is a physical "type" which teaches conversion. The ark represents Christ who protects the newly born child of God during their time of judgment (why the believer does not experience wrath during judgment). The people who die in the flood (judgment) represent the child of the Devil who is destroyed from within the believer.

All the various "end-time" prophecies are teachings on the pathway to salvation that leads to an Elect person's conversion. The Elect are the only ones who will have the "ends of the ages" come upon them before they die:

1Cor 10:11 Now all these things happened to them as types, and have been written for our admonition, <u>upon whom the ends of the ages are come</u>.

The mainstream teachings on end-time prophecy come from a carnal understanding of scripture. None of what is commonly taught is true.

The end-time prophecies are spiritual teachings of the New Covenant. The signs of the times are spiritual events that occur within an Elect believer just before and during the time that they are going through the conversion process. After they are converted, the ends of the ages have come

upon them.

1Cor 10:11 Now all these things happened to them as types, and have been written for our admonition, <u>upon whom the ends of the ages are come</u>.

How can the ends of the ages come upon the Elect before they die if what you believe is true?

Your understanding of the end-time prophecy is physical and outward which is how a person understands the Old Covenant. The New Covenant is different. It is spiritual and its teachings apply <u>within</u> a person.

When a believer is indwelt with the spirit of anti-Christ, that spirit profanes God's temple (the believer where the Holy Spirit dwells). This is when the Abomination of Desolation occurs and it happens to all believers while they are unconverted babes. That is why after Christ "comes again" and pours out the Latter Rain of the Spirit & heals the spiritual blindness of the believer, they will be able to see the Abomination of Desolation which previously occurred within themselves. It is at that time when the man of sin is revealed and when the believer discovers that they are that man of sin.

After Paul's death, Satan devoured the flock via the spirit of anti-Christ. Nothing has changed since that time. If a believer has not seen the A of D, they are not converted but remain under Satan's deceptions in the apostate church.

The way you understand end-time prophecy, it has not ever applied in the lives of any of the Elect to this day. If that were so, the ends of the ages could not have come upon the Elect and Paul was mistaken when he wrote 1Cor 10:11.

Realities are both physical and spiritual.

The physical reality of 70 AD marked the complete physical and spiritual end of the old covenant, and the full inauguration of the physical and spiritual realities of the New Covenant.

Neither reality can exist without the other.

The Judaean Christians physically fled in 66 AD in response to Jesus' warning, and preserved their lives both physically and spiritually.

The abomination of desolation of Matthew 24:15 is identified in the parallel synoptic verse of Luke 21:20 as the Roman armies which physically invaded and desolated Jerusalem in 70 AD.



The Old Covenant <u>ended</u> upon Christ's crucifixion. The Law did not end - only the Old Covenant way of approaching God ended. At that time, the temple of God changed from being the physical temple to being a spiritual temple (the believer). All the New Covenant teachings of Christ need to be understood and applied in this manner. You must move pass the Old Covenant way of understanding.

Consider this: John wrote his four letters AFTER the destruction of the temple in 70 A. D. If the temple's destruction was the fulfillment of the prophesied event of Mat 24:15 as you claim, why didn't John mention it in his letters? John didn't mention it because it was not the fulfillment of that prophecy.

Also, in Mat 24:14, Christ was talking about the "end" coming. Then in verse 15, He immediately mentions the A of D as one of the "signs of the times" which immediately proceeds His second coming. If the destruction of the temple in 70 A. D. was the A of D that Christ mentioned, why didn't the "end" come and Christ appear at that time? In fact, according to your beliefs, Christ still has not come back even to this day (over 1900 years). Why did Christ even mention the A of D if it was not relevant to His return?

When a person understands Christ's teachings as being spiritual teachings that apply <u>within</u> each of His Elect, the prophecies of the end-time make perfect sense and it eliminates all the contradictions that your carnal understanding of the prophecies have with other scripture.

With a spiritual understanding of the prophecies, the prophecies have been <u>vitally relevant to all</u> <u>the Elect</u> since the death of Paul when the spirit of anti-Christ devoured the church. In fact, many of the parables, types and analogies that Christ uses to teach the truths of the New Covenant, all present the same spiritual signs that Christ teaches in Matthew chapter 24 (for those with eyes that can see). Those "signs" are teaching the spiritual events that will happen to each of His Elect which lead up to and include their conversion. Christ came to save mankind and His teachings of the New Covenant present exactly how He will accomplish it. They are not one-time physical events which occur out in the world as you believe. The prophecies are just as relevant today to every Elect believer as they were when John wrote the book of Revelation. The time for their fulfillment was already "at hand" when John received the vision:

Rev 1:3 Blessed is he that readeth, and they that hear the words of this prophecy, and <u>keep</u> those things which are written therein: for <u>THE TIME IS AT HAND</u>.

Rev 22:7 Behold, <u>I come QUICKLY</u>: blessed is he that <u>keepeth the sayings of the prophecy</u> <u>of this book</u>.

Since the teachings of end-time prophecy present the spiritual events that led up to conversion,

each Elect person must "keep those things which are written therein" to be saved. In this sense, the "time is at hand" for the fulfillment of those prophecies. Because this is the true meaning of the prophecies, Christ must come <u>quickly</u> to each of His Elect before they physically die or they would not be converted.

Christ's second coming is therefore a <u>reoccurring spiritual event</u> that has happened to each of the Elect down through this age - and that is exactly how scripture describes His second coming:

Rev 1:4 John to the seven churches which are in Asia: Grace be unto you, and peace, from him <u>which is, and which was, and which is to come</u>; and from the seven Spirits which are before his throne...

Rev 1:8 I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending, saith the Lord, <u>which is, and</u> <u>which was, and which is to come</u>, the Almighty.

Rev 4:8 And the four beasts had each of them six wings about him; and they were full of eyes within: and they rest not day and night, saying, Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, which was, and is, and is to come.

Rev 11:17 saying: "We give You thanks, O Lord God Almighty, <u>the One who is and who</u> <u>was and who is to come</u>, because you have taken your great power and reigned (His reign occurs within each believer after they are converted).

If Christ doesn't come to a believer before they die, they are not one of the Elect.

You need to consider the truths presented in the scriptures which I quoted above and then <u>reconsider</u> your understanding of the prophecies. They do not teach what you and others believe.

The Old Covenant was physical & outward and was based upon the works of man. It was never a spiritual covenant. When the New Covenant began, the Old Covenant ended even though the Jews did not know this truth. The physical destruction of the temple was not the A of D. You are missing how the A of D applies to a believer under the New Covenant.

When Christ said "when you see the Abomination of Desolation", Christ was addressing His Elect because it is only the Elect who will come out from Satan's deceptions after He has given them "eyes that can see". After the Elect come to this knowledge of the truth, judgment will then fall "within" them to remove and destroy the spirit of anti-Christ and the Great Harlot (worsened carnal nature). This judgment is presented in detail in Rev 19:11-21 and Mat 24:37-41. Unless a believer sees the A of D before they die, they will not saved in this age. They will receive their portion with the unbelievers in the Lake of Fire and be saved at the end of the final age.

You said:

You're ignoring the Luke 21:20 identification of the abomination of desolation; and you're ignoring the historic flight of the Judaean Christians in direct response to Jesus' warning.

I am not ignoring Luke 21:20. Like Mat 24:15, that scripture is a spiritual teaching of Christ under the New Covenant and is presented in Christ's "another language" (**Isa 28:9-12**) which uses "spirit" words (**John 6:63**). Spirit words are defined by "comparing spiritual things with spiritual" (**1Cor 2:13**). In addition, spirit words should be applied "within" a person and not out in the world as you are doing. Until a believer can understand the spiritual language of Christ and apply its teachings correctly, they are not going to be able to understand the truth of Christ's New Covenant teachings. Christ (God's Word) will remain veiled to them.

Here is the scripture in Luke:

Luke 21:20 And when ye shall see Jerusalem compassed with armies, then know that the desolation thereof is nigh. 21 Then let them which are in Judaea flee to the mountains; and let them which are in the midst of it depart out; and let not them that are in the countries enter thereinto.

Luke 21:20-21 is <u>not</u> a teaching on the Abomination of Desolation. It is a teaching on the judgment (Day of the Lord) that follows the Latter Rain of the Spirit. It is the same judgment that is described in Mat 24:37-41 and in Rev 19:11-21.

The spirit word "Jerusalem" is referring to the <u>earthly</u> Jerusalem (the one below/the natural) which represents a believer's worsened carnal nature. It is this carnal nature that is the source of

mankind's sin. It is synonymous with the spirit words "Great Harlot", "Sodom" and "Egypt" (and even Damascus). When judgment falls on a believer, earthly Jerusalem will be removed and destroyed from within them. The "armies" are spiritual armies which are made up of Christ's angels which bring truth to the believer. One of the truths that they will bring to the believer is the knowledge of the Abomination of Desolation that previously occurred within them. When the believer sees the A of D (as taught in Mat 24:15), judgment will fall and destroy earthly Jerusalem. Earthly Jerusalem (the natural) will then be replaced with the new spiritual nature of the Holy Spirit (New Jerusalem, the spiritual).

This concept applies:

1Cor 15:46 Howbeit that *was* not first which is spiritual, but that which is natural; and afterward that which is spiritual.

You said:

And you're ignoring the wisdom and discernment of acknowledged historical exegetes of the true Christian Church for 17 centuries, who were unanimous in their recognition of the historicity of the physical destruction of Jerusalem.

The "historical exegetes of the true Christian Church for 17 centuries" were apostate "babes" who were spiritually blind and under Satan's deceptions. They are the ministers of Satan mentioned in this scripture:

2Cor 11:14 And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light. 15 <u>Therefore it is no great thing if his ministers also be transformed as the ministers of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their works</u>.

After Paul's death, the churches that he and the other apostles started all become apostate via the spirit of anti-Christ (Acts 20:29-31). Since that time, the true church has only been made up of <u>converted</u> believers who have passed through the apostate church. They are "few" in number and are invisible to this world.

Dear C____,

I was converted on Oct. 8th 2005 at the age of 44 after having spent most of my life in the apostate church. After my conversion, I never went back to any organized church because they are all apostate.

Though there are many beliefs contained in the various apostate churches of this world, they all have one common denominator - the belief in man's supposed free will ability to accept or reject Christ. This belief is the foundation that causes a believer to mix works with faith (this is the sin that leads to death). Most apostate churches don't even understand what constitutes the mixing works with faith. I have met some apostate believers who deny the Doctrine of Free Will but when you examine their beliefs, they still practice it but just don't realize it.

A believer mixes works with faith when they believe that their confession of faith or their repentance came from their own free will decision to make that choice. But the truth is, mankind has no such ability to have faith or to repent apart from Christ causing it to happen. When Christ is ready to cause an unbeliever to make a confession of faith and to enter the church, He will come to them without their asking or permission. When Christ comes, He will give them the Early Rain of the Spirit. The Early Rain of the Spirit will give them their faith. Without the Spirit, they would remain an unbeliever until they die.

This verse applies:

1Cor 12:3 Wherefore I give you to understand, that no man speaking by the Spirit of God calleth Jesus accursed: and that no man can say that Jesus is the Lord, but by the Holy Spirit.

Paul received the Early Rain of the Spirit on the Damascus Road when he was on his way to persecute Christians. But everything changed for Paul immediately after Christ gave him the Early Rain of the Spirit. Paul fall to his knees and called Jesus "Lord". Paul then submitted to Christ's authority over him when Paul asked Christ "what do you want me to do?" Paul was then led by the hand into Damascus. Paul's blindness represented his spiritual blindness. In Damascus,

Paul was unable to eat or drink (represents his inability to consume Christ's bread and New Wine). Paul remained in Damascus for three days in this condition. The number three represents the spiritual process that Paul was going through to become a "man of sin" in the apostate church. After the three days were complete, Christ came a second time to Paul (typed by Ananias). To arrive, Ananias (Christ) travelled on a street named "straight" (represents Paul's repentance from works which made Christ's pathway straight). When Christ arrived, Paul was staying in a house owned by a man named Judas. This represents Paul's apostate condition. To restore Paul, Paul was baptized by the Spirit (Latter Rain) which restored his salvation and healed his blindness. After Paul received the free gift of the Spirit, Paul was able to start consuming the truth of Christ for the first time.

All the Elect will travel the "type" that Paul's conversion taught. Christ does all the spiritual work of making it happen. In this age, Christ is only converting those who have been chosen from the foundation of the world to be heirs/First Fruits. The balance of mankind will die in their sins and be cast into the Lake of Fire (represents judgment, not literal fire) upon their resurrection. In the Lake of Fire, they will be judged by the Law. The penalty of sin according to the Law is death. However, before anyone perishes by this judgment, Christ will have mercy upon them and give them the Early and Latter Rains of the Spirit. This will give them the faith they need for Christ to appear to them. When Christ does, He will gather the newly born child of God to heaven. The child of the devil will remain under judgment in the Lake of Fire until he perishes. This will satisfy justice.

This verse applies to this time of judgment:

Mat 23:23 Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye pay tithe of mint and anise and cummin, and have omitted the weightier matters of the law: <u>justice, mercy, and faith</u>: these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone.

By the end of the final age, all mankind will be converted from being a child of the devil who sins into being a child of God who is sinless. This is how Christ saves the world and it happens solely by the works of Christ.

The truth that is presented by Paul's conversion experience is presented over and over again in scripture. You just do not have the eyes to see it.

In Rev 11, the type presented by the "two witnesses" teaches the same pathway that Paul's conversion taught. All the Elect are represented by two witnesses - they are not two figures who appear on the world scene at the literal end of the age as commonly taught.

When the two witnesses are killed by Satan and lie dead in earthly Jerusalem, this is when they became apostate and spiritually died. Their dead was not a physical death as most suppose. Christ words are spirit and they apply "within" a person. When a believer sees the death as being a physical death, they are seeing Christ (God's Word) carnally.

When the two witnesses received the "Spirit of life from God" it represented them receiving the Latter Rain of the Spirit. Next, they rose to their feet and Christ gathered them to heaven. Again, this is spiritual event that happens within them. They do not literally rise and go to heaven. The event represents their spiritual change from being of this world to being in the Kingdom of Heaven. This is the same event described in Mat 24:29-31.

Judgment of the believer then followed:

Rev 11:13 And the same hour was there a great earthquake, and the tenth part of the city fell, and in the earthquake were slain of men seven thousand: and the remnant were affrighted, and gave glory to the God of heaven.

The great earthquake is a symbol for the believer being spiritually changed (converted). Instead of seeing Christ through a carnal paradigm, the believer will now see Christ through a spiritual paradigm. This occurs because Christ healed their spiritual blindness. The truth that they received is what brings judgment to them. The "tenth" part of the city (themselves) falls to represent their conversion. The seven thousand men that were slain represents the destruction of the spirit of anti-Christ which had indwelt them. The remnant that were "affrighted" were the remaining carnal thoughts and beliefs that remained within the believer's mind and which will be dealt with by Christ's chastisement and their increase in knowledge as they mature into a perfect man of full age. That judgment of the remnant of carnal beliefs is also shown in Rev 19:21.

Because Christ's teaches in His spiritual language, the truth of what I presented to you is veiled to all but those who have had their spiritual blindness healed upon their conversion.

Remember this scripture below that I presented in a previous post?

Isa 28:9 <u>Whom shall he teach knowledge? and whom shall he make to understand</u> <u>doctrine</u>? them that are weaned from the milk, and drawn from the breasts (converted believers). 10 For precept must be upon precept, precept upon precept; line upon line, line upon line; here a little, and there a little: 11 For with stammering lips and <u>another</u> <u>language</u> (spiritual language) will he speak to this people. 12 But the word of the LORD was unto them precept upon precept, precept upon precept; line upon line, line upon line; here a little, and there a little; that they (babes in Christ/Early Rain only) might go, and <u>fall</u> <u>backward, and be broken, and snared, and taken</u> (by Satan).

The truth that Isa 28:9-12 teaches is retaught over and over again in scripture:

Here is where Christ teaches a portion of this truth again:

Mat 12:43 When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walketh through dry places, seeking rest, and findeth none. 44 Then he saith, I will return into my house from whence I came out; and when he is come, he findeth it empty, swept, and garnished. 45 Then goeth he, and <u>taketh with himself SEVEN other spirits more wicked than himself</u>, and they enter in and dwell there: and the <u>last state of that man is worse than the first</u>. Even so shall it be also unto this wicked generation.

The spiritual symbol of an unclean spirit represents a spirit which teaches Satan's false truth through lies and deceptions.

Since a new believer remains <u>spiritually blind</u> (Mark 8:21-25) after receiving the Early Rain of the Spirit, they cannot replace their worldly false beliefs with the truth of Christ. ONE unclean spirit leaves but comes back with SEVEN more. The number "seven" represents perfection. In this case, the number seven represents the perfection of Satan's lies/deceptions which come to a believer by the indwelling of the spirit of anti-Christ. Now, instead of ONE unclean spirit within the believer, they now have EIGHT. The number eight is a spiritual symbol which represents a <u>new spiritual condition</u>. In this case, the new spiritual condition is <u>worse than the first</u>.

This "worse than the first" spiritual condition causes the believer to become a <u>False Prophet</u>, a <u>Man of Sin</u>, a <u>Minister of Satan</u> and a <u>Seven Headed Beast with Ten Horns & Crowns</u>.

One more comment: All the parables that begin with the phrase "the Kingdom of Heaven is like" are teaching portions of the pathway to salvation that the Elect will travel. And as the Parable of the Wheat and the Tares presents, the seed of the Holy Spirit (Early Rain) and the seed of Satan (spirit of anti-Christ) will both be planted in the field (the believer) before the time of harvest arrives (Latter Rain & judgment).

This verse applies to the time of the harvest:

1Sam 12:17 Is it not wheat harvest to day? (day of conversion for the Elect) I will call unto the LORD, and he shall send thunder (voice of Christ) and RAIN (the Latter Rain); <u>that ve may perceive and see that your wickedness is great</u> (have become a "man of sin") which ye have done in the sight of the LORD, in asking you a king (Satan).

Are you able to "see" anything that these scriptures I've presented are teaching? They apply to all believers in this age if they have been chosen for salvation. None of the Elect (since Paul's death) will travel a different pathway to salvation.

Here is my response to your second post:

The true church is made up of converted Elect believers. They will experience the apostate church (the nearly 2,000 different denominations/sects of Christianity) but Christ will pull them out at the time of their harvest. Like the Wise Virgins, the Elect will be given the extra flask of oil so that Christ's pathway to them will be made straight. When Christ appears, He will gather them back to heaven for the marriage.

Ephesians 3:20-21 rebuts your delusion about the church becoming apostate.

Dear C____,

The "church" is made up of faithful believers. However, since the death of Paul, the only faithful believers are the converted Elect - all the babes have been consumed by the wolves (ministers of Satan) in the apostate church and are no longer faithful.

Here is the scripture you quoted:

Eph 3:20-21 Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us, 21 Unto him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus throughout all ages, world without end. Amen.

At the time Paul wrote his letter to the Ephesians, the "falling away" had not yet occurred. But now that the apostasy has occurred, only the converted Elect believers are the faithful and true church.

Consider what Paul said here to the Corinthians:

2Cor 11:2 For I am jealous over you with godly jealousy: for I have espoused you to one husband, that I may present you as a <u>chaste virgin</u> to Christ. 3 But I fear, lest by any means, as the serpent beguiled Eve through his subtilty, so your minds should be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ. 4 For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or if ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with him.

In this scripture, Paul is using the <u>marriage analogy</u> which teaches the pathway to salvation. It is used throughout God's Word.

When an unbeliever receives the Early Rain of the Spirit from Christ, they become a "chaste virgin" and begin their time of waiting for the Bridegroom to return for the marriage (conversion). While a chaste virgin waits for the Bridegroom to return (the second coming of Christ), they are easy prey for Satan because the virgin remains <u>carnally minded and spiritually blind</u>. In this condition, Satan will deceive the virgin and cause them to spiritually fornicate with him. Eve committed fornication with Satan in the Garden of Eden and that is why Paul mentions her in verse 3. Spiritual fornication occurs when the virgin believes what Satan tells them over what Christ has told them.

Satan's primary lie that he uses to deceive the virgin is that salvation requires a person to mix their own works with faith. The Doctrine of Free Will taught in the apostate church is this lie's foundation. The mixing of works with faith is like mixing the Old Covenant (based on man's works) with the New Covenant (based on Christ's works) or like trying to serve two masters (Satan & Christ).

When a virgin accepts Satan's lie, they are <u>spiritually fornicating</u> with Satan and have committed the sin that leads to death. In other words, the virgin is no longer chaste and is no longer acceptable to the Bridegroom. They have lost their salvation.

This is how Satan kills the saints and how he builds his apostate church which masquerades as the true church to this world. This is also how Satan killed the "two witnesses" in Rev 11:7 and how he kills the saints in Mat 24:9.

After a believer commits the sin of "falling away" (sin that leads to death), they cannot be renewed by repentance:

Heb 6:1 Therefore leaving the principles of the doctrine of Christ, let us go on unto perfection; <u>not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works, and of faith toward God</u>, 2 Of the doctrine of baptisms, and of laying on of hands, and of resurrection of the dead, and age-enduring judgment. 3 And this will we do, if God permit. 4 <u>For it is impossible for those who were once enlightened</u>, and have <u>TASTED of the heavenly gift (the Early Rain/a small amount/not the Latter Rain) and were made partakers of the Holy Spirit, 5 and have <u>TASTED the good word of God</u> (Christ and Him crucified/no</u>

spiritual understanding) and the powers of the world to come 6 if they shall <u>fall away</u> (mix works with faith), <u>to renew them again unto repentance</u>: seeing they crucify to themselves the Son of God afresh, and put him to an open shame.

But since Christ is harvesting the first fruits in this age, the Elect's days as a "man of sin" will be "shortened" (**Mat 24:22**) so that they can be harvested early - this is in comparison to the "many" who will be harvested later at the end of the final age (the main harvest of mankind at year's end).

To accomplish the Elect's shortening of the days, Christ will come again and give the unchaste virgin the Latter Rain of the Spirit. With the Latter Rain, the virgin will be repent of her works and become faithful again. The Bridegroom will then appear and gather his virgin to heaven for the marriage to take place. After the marriage ceremony, the Marriage Supper of the Lamb will occur. This is when the Bridegroom feeds his new bride his bread and New Wine. This is now possible because the virgin's spiritual blindness was healed when they received the Latter Rain of the Spirit. It is at this point that the bride will "see" the Abomination of Desolation that previously occurred when the spirit of anti-Christ entered them (God's temple). Judgment will then fall which will complete their conversion. This teaching is presented in Revelation chapter 19.

Other details of the marriage analogy are given in the Parable of the Ten Virgins. In that parable, both the Wise and the Foolish Virgins start off as being chaste. However, after Satan comes to all ten virgins, he will deceive them and cause them to fall away. At this point, they all sleep and slumber at night (have spiritually died) and are no longer chaste. They have spiritually fornicated with Satan.

At midnight (the deepest part of the virgin's spiritual blindness), a call will go out that the Bridegroom is returning. This is the same call that John the Baptist made to the Jewish Nation. It a call to repent of works so that the Bridegroom's path will be made straight. For the Wise Virgins, they will use the extra flask of oil (Latter Rain) which will cause them to repent of their works. The light that is oil gives off is the truth of the New Covenant (faith). They will then be restored so that the can go out to meet the Bridegroom.

The Foolish Virgins (the "many" who are called to be saints but were not chosen) will remain unchaste and will not acceptable to the Bridegroom. Upon their resurrection, the Bridegroom will say that He never knew them and will cast them into the Lake of Fire with the unbelievers. At this end of that age though, Christ will have mercy upon them and give them the faith they need to be restored. They will then be saved but will lose the rewards that the Bride received. This verse applies to them:

1Cor 3:13 Every man's work shall be made manifest: for the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire; and the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is. 14 If any man's work abide which he hath built thereupon, he (the Wise Virgins) shall receive a

reward (life during the ages and reigning with Christ). 15 If any man's work shall be burned, he (the Foolish Virgins) shall suffer loss: but he himself shall be saved; yet so as by fire (the Lake of Fire in the final age).

Does any of what I presented above make sense to you?

I have one final comment to make: When Christ is ready to "come again" to one of His fallen way Elect, He will cause them to pray for understanding or for anything else that only the Latter Rain of the Spirit can give them. This is the prayer that Paul was praying in Acts 9:11 which caused Ananias (Christ) to come to him and pour out the Latter Rain of the Spirit. It is the same prayer Christ mentions below:

Luke 11:9 And I say unto you, Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you. 10 For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened. 11 If a son shall ask bread of any of you that is a father, will he give him a stone? or if he ask a fish, will he for a fish give him a serpent? 12 Or if he shall ask an egg, will he offer him a scorpion? 13 If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: <u>how much more shall your heavenly</u> Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask him?

"Throughout all ages" meant and means that the True Church would and will never cease to be.

Whether you believe it or not.

Since you believe that everything is spiritual and nothing is physical, you do not believe in the first coming of Christ in the flesh.

That was a physical event.

Dear C____,

Yes, the true church has always existed and I have not said differently. You are confusing the true church with the apostate church and its nearly 2,000 different denominations/sects in this world.

I believe that the first coming of Christ was in the flesh just as you believe.

Here's why:

When Christ came in the flesh, it was under the Old Covenant of Law. The Old Covenant is physical & outward and because it is, the works that Christ performed under the Old Covenant can be seen with human eyes. Carnally minded and spiritually blind believers (babes) have no trouble understanding the work that Christ did in the flesh under the Old Covenant.

However, spiritually blind "babes" have a great deal of difficulty understanding the spiritual work that Christ is presently doing under the New Covenant. That work cannot be seen with human eyes.

Paul encountered this spiritual blindness issue with the Corinthians church (all babes) and discussed it with them in his first letter. Paul even made these direct statements about them not being able to understand the spiritual truths of the New Covenant:

1Cor 2:2 For I determined not to know anything among you, <u>save Jesus Christ, and him</u> <u>crucified</u>.

1Cor 3:1 And I, brethren, could not speak unto you as unto spiritual, but as unto carnal, even as unto babes in Christ. 2 I have fed you with milk (Christ and Him crucified), and not with meat: for hitherto ye were not able to bear it, neither yet now are ye able. 3 For ye are yet carnal: for whereas there is among you envying, and strife, and divisions, are ye not carnal, and walk as men?

So, yes, Christ came the first time in the flesh. After a believer receives the Early Rain of the Spirit, this is how they "see" (understand) Christ. But when Christ appears a second time to a believer they will "see" Him spiritually after He gives them the Latter Rain. This is the moment of salvation as Paul says:

Heb 9:28 So Christ was sacrificed once to take away the sins of many; and he will <u>appear a</u> <u>second time</u>, not to bear sin, but <u>to bring salvation to those who are waiting for him</u> (as virgins waiting on a Bridegroom).

You said: "After Paul's death, the churches that he and the other apostles started *all become apostate*".

The confusion lies with you.

If you believe that the first coming of Christ was a physical event, why do you not believe that the destruction of Jerusalem was a physical event?

Dear C____,

I do believe that the destruction of Jerusalem was a physical historical event <u>but it is not</u> <u>mentioned in scripture</u>. The destruction of the Jerusalem in scripture is contained in spiritual teachings of Christ.

There are TWO spiritual Jerusalem's in the New Covenant teachings:

Gal 4:25 For this Agar is mount Sinai in Arabia, and answereth to 1). <u>Jerusalem which now</u> <u>is</u>, and is in bondage with her children. 26 But 2). <u>Jerusalem which is above</u> is free, which is the mother of us all.

1). The Jerusalem "which now is" is a symbol for carnal mankind - and even more specifically, it represents mankind's marred and carnal spirit. This Jerusalem causes mankind to be in bondage to sin and it rules over man's mind, making it carnal as well.

The symbol "Jerusalem, which is now" has several synonymous terms: <u>Sodom</u>, <u>Egypt</u>, <u>wicked</u> <u>heart</u> and <u>Mystery Babylon the Great Harlot</u>.

The symbol "woman" is also used to depict mankind's marred spirit/carnal nature. Here is one example:

Mat 13:33 Another parable spake he unto them; The kingdom of heaven is like unto leaven (false teachings), which a WOMAN (man's carnal spirit) took (from Satan), and HID (represent deception) in three measures (a spiritual process) of meal (bread/truth), <u>till the whole was leavened</u>.

The leavened loaf of bread masquerades as the truth of Christ which Satan feeds to spiritually blind "babes" - making them fall away from faith. This is how Satan kills the saints and builds his apostate church. And since the leaven is hidden in the bread, the babe doesn't know that they

are being deceived. This is the nature of deception - a believer cannot know that they are being deceived while it is happening. That is why when a believer's spiritual blindness is healed, they can finally come out of Satan's deceptions and see the Abomination of Desolation that previously occurred with themselves.

Eve and several other women in scripture are a "types" for man's carnal spirit and that is why Eve was made from Adam's rib <u>and</u> why the BEAR (Satan) is shown eating 3 ribs. Satan is consuming "babes" through their carnal spirits. Satan "eats the dust of the ground" and kills mankind though our carnality.

Note: Have you ever wondered why scripture says that none of Christ's bones were broken (**John 19:36**)? It is because the symbol "bone" represents the spirit of a person. A broken bone represents that the individual has sinned and spiritually died. Since Christ never sinned, scripture says that none of His bones were broken.

Here are some scriptures on the different symbols for earthly Jerusalem:

Rev 11:8 And their dead bodies shall lie in the street of the great city (earthly Jerusalem), which spiritually is called <u>Sodom</u> and <u>Egypt</u>, where also our Lord was crucified.

Rev 17:1 And there came one of the seven angels which had the seven vials, and talked with me, saying unto me, Come hither; I will shew unto thee the judgment of the <u>Great</u> <u>Harlot</u> that sitteth upon many waters:

Rev 17:5 And upon her forehead was a name written, MYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT (HARLOT), THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS (all the world religions) AND ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH.

Rev 17:18 And the woman (Great Harlot) which thou sawest is that great city (earthly Jerusalem), which reigneth over the kings of the earth (thoughts and beliefs of mankind).

The destruction of the Great Harlot/earthly Jerusalem is depicted in Rev chapter 18. This destruction happens during the conversion process of each Elect person. It is not a one time event.

2). The Jerusalem "which is above" is the <u>New Jerusalem</u> and it is represents the converted Elect - and even more specifically, it represents the Elect person's spirit which is governed by the Holy Spirit.

Eze 36:26 A new heart (New Jerusalem) also will I give you, and a new spirit (Holy Spirit) will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh.

Rev 21:20 And I John saw the holy city, <u>New Jerusalem</u>, coming down from God out of heaven, <u>prepared as a bride adorned for her husband</u>.

One more scripture:

Dan 9:24 Seventy weeks are determined upon thy people (OT faithful) and upon thy holy city (New Jerusalem/Elect/Bride), to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy.

The Seventy weeks prophecy will be complete after Christ has saved the last Elect person in this age. The first 69 1/2 weeks were completed at the cross under the Old Covenant. Christ was crucified in the "midst" of the 70th week. This 69 1/2 weeks of years was literal time. The last 3 1/2 weeks are being completed within each Elect person under the New Covenant which is spiritual. The last 3 1/2 years begins for an Elect person when Christ gives them the Early Rain of the Spirit. It ends when the person is given the Latter Rain of the Spirit and is converted. The time (not literal time) in between the two Rains of the Spirit is a time of drought and was "typed" by Elijah's 3 1/2 year drought. Anytime you see the symbols "time, times and a half", 42 months, 3 1/2 years or 1260 days, it is spiritual teaching on the time an Elect believer spends between them receiving the Early and Latter Rains - it is time of "great tribulation" when the believer dwells in the wilderness and becomes apostate.

Does any of this make sense to you?

Jesus physical birth is mentioned in Scripture.

Why is Jerusalem's physical destruction not mentioned in Scripture?

Dear C____,

Since the physical destruction of Jerusalem is not mentioned in scripture (either prophesied beforehand or in a historical sense), it didn't suit the purposes of God to include it. The opposite is true for the birth of Christ.

I wanted to include the following comments below in my previous post on the first coming of Christ but I didn't have time to add them to my post. I will do so now.

As I said earlier, the first coming of Christ was "in the flesh" and was under the Old Covenant. It was a visible, physical and outward event that carnal mankind could witness and understand

(belief is another matter).

Under the New Covenant, the phrase "in the flesh" means something completely different.

Since the Early Rain of the Spirit does not heal a new believer's spiritual blindness, scripture says that Christ will appear to the new believer "in the flesh". This means that because the new believer remains carnally minded & spiritually blind after Christ first comes to them with the Early Rain of the Spirit, they will only be able to see (understand) Christ in a carnal way. In other words, the new believer will try to understand the spiritual teachings of Christ (God's Word) in a literal, outward and physical way rather than in a spiritual way. The spiritual way recognizes that Christ's words are spirit (John 6:63) and that those words carry a different meaning than what man's wisdom teaches (1Cor 2:13). To understand those spirit words, their definitions must be spiritually discerned by the Holy Spirit and by comparing spirit words with how those same words are used elsewhere in scripture. It is a mistake to look out in the world for a spirit word's meaning. For example, the spirit "bear" represents Satan and does not represent Russia as some believe.

Below is another example using the spirit word "sword":

Mat 26:52 Then said Jesus unto him, put up again thy sword into his place: for all they that take the sword shall perish with the sword.

Does Christ really mean that if you use a sword to kill others, then you must likewise be killed with a sword?

If His words were carnal, then that would be what Christ is teaching here. But Christ's words are not carnal, they are spiritual.

Also, if we understand this verse in a carnal way, Christ's statement can easily be proven to be <u>false</u>. There are countless examples of people who have used violence to kill others but then do not die from that same type of violence - it almost goes without saying.

So, is Christ mistaken in this scripture <u>or</u> is Christ speaking in "another language" (Isa 28:9-12) and He means something entirely different?

In **Matt 26:52**, Christ is using the spirit word "sword" to teach us a spiritual message. To understand what this spiritual word represents, we must look at how it is used elsewhere in scripture. In other words, we must <u>compare spiritual things with spiritual</u>.

Eph 6:17 And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, <u>which is the word of</u> <u>God</u>:

Heb 4:12 For the word of God *is* quick, and powerful, and sharper than any two edge

sword...

Rev 1:16 And he had in his right hand seven stars: and <u>out of his mouth</u> went a sharp twoedged sword...

From the verses presented above, it is very easy to understand that the spirit word sword represents the Word of God who is Christ.

Christ's hidden spiritual point He is making in Matt 26:52 is that <u>all who take up the</u> <u>sword</u> (unconverted babes, Early Rain only), will perish by the sword (spiritual death of the child of the devil). This death is a necessary part of the <u>conversion process</u> which occurs when the Word of God (Christ/Sword) comes to a person and gives them the Baptism of the Holy Spirit (Latter Rain) and the Baptism of Fire (judgment).

Mat 3:11 I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: <u>he shall baptize you with the Holy</u> <u>Spirit (Latter Rain), and with Fire (judgment of the Day of the Lord)</u>.

The baptism of the Holy Spirit, followed by judgment is what Christ does "within" a "babe" to convert them.

This verse applies to conversion:

Jer 18:4 And the vessel that he made of clay was marred in the hand of the potter: so he made it again another vessel, as seemed good to the potter to make it.

The conversion event is what the Apostles experienced on the Day of Pentecost:

Acts 2:1 And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. 2 And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting. 3 And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of <u>FIRE</u>, and it sat upon each of them. 4 And they were all filled with the <u>HOLY SPIRIT</u>, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

In the spiritual language of Christ, the Apostles took up the sword and then they died by the SWORD.

The second coming of Christ is another good example of carnal understanding vs. spiritual understanding.

A carnal understanding of the second coming of Christ "sees" it as a physical & outward one time event which occurs where human eyes can see Him.

A spiritual understanding of the second coming of Christ sees it as a spiritual reoccurring event that happens "within" the Elect. Human eyes will not be able to witness it.

Now back to the spiritual meaning of "in the flesh".

John uses it in the scripture below:

1John 4:3 And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come <u>in the flesh</u> is not of God: and this is that <u>spirit of antichrist</u>, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world.

Like Christ, John teaches in Christ's spiritual language. In this verse, John is not talking about when Christ literally came in the flesh under the Old Covenant and went to the cross.

John is teaching that an apostate believer will deny the first coming of Christ when Christ came to them and gave them the Early Rain of the Spirit. It is the Early Rain of the Spirit that caused Christ to appear to them in a carnal way (in the flesh). But an apostate believer won't accept this truth. They believe that when Christ first appeared to them, He did so as He really is and that He baptized them with the Spirit. They don't realize that they are still carnally minded, spiritually blind, unconverted and under Satan's deceptions.

And like the Pharisees, they will say that they can "see" (spiritually) when they cannot:

John 9:40 And some of the Pharisees which were with him heard these words, and said unto him, Are we blind also? 41 Jesus said unto them, If ye were blind, ye should have no sin: but now ye say, We see; therefore your sin remaineth.

This verse also applies to them:

John 8:44 Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.

And this scripture, too:

Rev 3:16 So then because thou art lukewarm (mixing works with faith/trying to serve two masters), and neither cold nor hot, I will spue thee out of my mouth. 17 Because thou sayest, I am rich (treasure in heaven), and increased with goods (knowledge of God), and have need of nothing; and knowest not that thou art <u>wretched</u>, and <u>miserable</u>, and <u>poor</u>, and <u>blind</u>, and <u>naked</u>:

I read my post from the night before and realized it didn't answer your question very well. I will try to do better in this post.

The events described and/or prophesied to be fulfilled under the Old Covenant are physical outward events - like the birth of Christ and His ministry that led Him to the cross. But once the Old Covenant ended and the New Covenant began, all the prophesied events left to be fulfilled are now being <u>spiritually</u> fulfilled <u>within</u> an individual person. There are no physical outward events left to be fulfilled because we are now under the New Covenant and that is why the destruction of physical Jerusalem in 70 A.D is not mentioned in scripture.

Daniel's 70 weeks prophecy is one of the most difficult prophecies to understand because portions of that prophecy are fulfilled under both the Old Covenant and the New Covenant (as I described in my last post). The first 69 1/2 weeks of years are fulfilled physically under the Old Covenant and ended at the cross. After the change to the New Covenant, the 3 1/2 years which remained of the prophecy are now being fulfilled spiritually within a person. Unless a person can make that transition from a physical way of understanding to a spiritual way of understanding, Daniel's prophecy is going to remain veiled to them.

One other point; many of the physical events that are recorded in the OT are "types" for what will happen spiritually under the New Covenant.

For example: Noah and the flood is a type for the Elect's spiritual conversion. The story of Lot and Sodom & Gomorrah is also a type for spiritual conversion. Because they are types for conversion, Christ mentioned those physical historical events in His end-time teachings. As I have said, the end-time prophecies are teaching the pathway to salvation. The "sign of the times" are spiritual events that happen <u>within</u> a believer which led up to and include the second coming of Christ when He converts the Elect person. Those events do not happen out in the world as carnally minded babes teach. <u>Those babes don't see the change that is needed when transitioning from the teachings of the Old Covenant to the teachings of the New Covenant</u>. To make this change, they need Christ to give them the Latter Rain of the Spirit and to heal their spiritual blindness. After Christ heals a person's spiritual blindness, they will then start rightly dividing the Word between the Old (physical) and the New (spiritual) covenants.

Dear FaithWillDo,

Scripture records a plethora of physical entities and events.

The physical destruction of physical Jerusalem is among them.

It's that simple.

Were the disciples physical people? Yes or no.

Is the disciples' physical meeting on the physical Day of Pentecost recorded in Scripture? Yes or no.

Is the disciples' physically speaking in physical tongues on that day recorded in Scripture? Yes or no.

Is Peter's physical address to those physically gathered on that day recorded in Scripture? Yes or no.

Is Peter and John physically going thereafter to the physical temple recorded in Scripture? Yes or no.

Is the physical city of Jerusalem recorded in Scripture? Yes or no.

Is Saul physically going to physical Jerusalem recorded in Scripture? Yes or no.

Is Peter physically coming to physical Jerusalem recorded in Scripture? Yes or no.

Is the physical destruction of physical Jerusalem recorded in Scripture? Yes or no.

Dear C____,

The physical destruction of Jerusalem is not mentioned in scripture. If you believe it is, show me the scripture.

The scripture in Luke 21:20 which you previously mentioned is a prophecy on the spiritual destruction of earthly Jerusalem within an Elect believer while they are going through spiritual process of conversion. There are no prophecies for the destruction of physical Jerusalem because all prophecy fulfilled under the New Covenant is spiritually fulfilled and not physically fulfilled. I suppose that John could have mentioned it in one of his letters because John wrote his letters after Jerusalem was physically destroyed. But if John would have mentioned it, it would <u>not</u> have been a fulfillment of prophecy - it would have been a physical <u>type</u> which would represent the spiritual destruction of Jerusalem as a type in one of John's letters, it was not mentioned.

As for your questions, what I have being saying is that the <u>teachings</u> of the NT are spiritual

teachings and the <u>prophecies</u> of the New Covenant are spiritually fulfilled. None of the prophecies are physically fulfilled under the New Covenant.

And of course, there are many physical happenings recorded in the NT. I have never said differently. The book of Acts is full of them. But those physical happenings are not "teachings" and they are not the fulfillment of prophecy. However, many of those physical events are <u>types</u> which teach spiritual truths.

Consider this physical type recorded below:

Acts 16:26 And suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken: and immediately all the doors were opened, and every one's bands were loosed.

This event is a type for what happens to an Elect believer when they are being converted. The great earthquake is a symbol that represents a spiritual event is taking place. The prison represents sin which holds mankind in bondage. When the doors of the prison are opened, it represents that the person has been converted and is no longer held captive by sin.

Dear C____,

You are still understanding Christ's end-time prophecies in a carnal way. Christ was not referring to the physical destruction of Jerusalem. He was referring to the destruction of spiritual Jerusalem (the one below) within a believer as they are being converted.

Here is the scripture that you are quoting:

Luke 21:20 And when ye shall see Jerusalem compassed with armies, then know that the desolation thereof is nigh. 21 Then let them which are in Judaea flee to the mountains; and let them which are in the midst of it depart out; and let not them that are in the countries

enter thereinto. 22 For these be the days of vengeance, that all things which are written may be fulfilled. 23 But woe unto them that are with child (the freewoman who is about to birth a child of God), and to them that give suck (the bondwoman who is nursing a worsened child of the devil), in those days! for there shall be great distress in the land (within the believer), and wrath upon this people (children of the devil). 24 And they shall fall by the edge of the sword (God's Word), and shall be led away captive into all nations (beliefs of the child of the devil will be held captive by the truth): and Jerusalem (carnal spirit of the believer) shall be trodden down of the Gentiles (works/unfaithful), until the times of the Gentiles be fulfilled (until conversion is complete).

Spiritual Jerusalem (that great city) is synonymous with Sodom and the Great Harlot. And like Lot, the Elect believer will not be harmed when it is destroyed from within them. For that reason, Christ says that when you see Jerusalem surrounded with armies (a spiritual sign of the times), then flee to the mountains like Lot did because judgement is about to fall. The "days of vengeance" is referring to the judgment that destroys all the things within a believer that has caused them to sin and spiritually die. One of those things which is destroyed is earthly Jerusalem. Earthly Jerusalem is also synonymous with the spirit word "Great Harlot". Her destruction is described in Rev 18. Notice that the same warning to come out of her is repeated there:

Rev 18:4 And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, <u>Come out of her, my people</u>, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues.

As I said, there are no scriptures which teach about the destruction of physical Jerusalem in 70 A.D.

Why are you avoiding the issue?

The Judaean Christians fled in direct response to Jesus' warning.

Were they wrong to flee?

Dear C____,

If the Judaean Christians fled as a direct response to Jesus' warning, they were misunderstanding His spiritual teaching in Luke 21:20. Also, how could they flee if the Roman army had already surrounded Jerusalem as the verse says? After all, the Roman army surrounding Jerusalem is the "sign" that Christ tells them to watch for. And if they could still flee after the city was

surrounded, why does Christ say to flee to the mountains as Lot did? Is there something special about the mountains? And why does Christ reference pregnant women and nursing mothers? Are not children and others going to suffer as well?

So what makes you believe that Christians in Jerusalem (if there were any left at that time because of the Jewish persecution) fled after the Roman armies arrived? Is there any first hand historical records that support your claim or is it just speculation on your part?

The teachings of Christ in Luke, Matthew and Mark on the "end-times" are His spiritual teachings on the events that led up to an Elect believer's conversion. Christ was sent to save the world by His Father. Why would Christ concern Himself with outward world events which are not related to His spiritual work of saving the Elect?

Christ also said (**Mat 10:28**) to not fear those who can kill the body (like the Roman army), so why the sudden change for the believers in Jerusalem in 70 A.D.? What about the other believers who have lived throughout this age? Are they less important than the Jerusalem believers in 70 A.D.?

None of the NT writers were concerned with what was happening in the world outside of the church so why would Christ be? John could have mentioned the destruction of Jerusalem and the fate of the believers there in at least one of his letters, but He didn't. Wasn't that event important to John since it was the fulfillment prophecy as you believe?

Your carnal understanding of end-time prophecy makes no sense in light of what scripture actually teaches and it is contradicted by many scriptures. You should be praying for the Baptism of the Spirit and for eyes that can see spiritually. Only with the gift of the Spirit will a person be able to understand the truth of Christ's spiritual teachings. No amount of supposed free will ability or personal intelligence can help a person see. Until Christ gives the gift of the Spirit to a person, the spiritual teachings of Christ are going to remain veiled from their understanding.
