

#24 EMAIL RESPONSE THAT SUMMARIZES THE GREAT MYSTERY OF CHRIST

Dear A \_\_\_\_\_,

Concerning the Great Mystery of Christ, let's begin with the two verses below:

**John 17:11 And now I am no more in the world, but these are in the world, and I come to thee. Holy Father, keep through thine own name those whom thou hast given me, that they may be one, as we are.**

**John 17:22 And the glory which thou gave me, I have given them (referring to the Holy Spirit); that they may be one, even as we are one **23 I in them, and and thou in me, (made possible by the indwelling of the Father's Spirit)** that they may be made perfect (converted) in one (all having the Holy Spirit); and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me.**

The Holy Spirit is the Father's Spirit. It is by the Holy Spirit that the Father gave to Christ that makes Christ and the Father "one". And it is by the Holy Spirit that Christ then gives to His converted Elect which will make them "one" with each other and with Christ & the Father.

The mystery of God that Paul mentions in the verse below is "Christ in you".

**Col 1:27 To whom God would make known what *is* the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory:**

And that mystery is "finished" when a person is converted. At that time, the person will become "one" with Christ and the Father & with other converted believers.

**Rev 10:7 But in the days of the voice of the seventh angel (when conversion comes to a person), when he shall begin to sound, the mystery of God should be finished, as he hath declared to his servants the prophets.**

Once converted and having the indwelling of the Holy Spirit (made perfect), a person will become part of God the Father's expanding family that continues until the last of mankind has been added to the Kingdom of Heaven (Christ's government).

**Isa 9:7 Of the increase of his government and peace there shall be NO END, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this (no works from mankind required).**

Only the "few" (the converted elect) will understand and accept what I presented above. This truth is the "Great Mystery" of Christ and his church:

**Eph 5:30 For we are members of his body, of his flesh, and of his bones. 31 For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother (carnal & marred Adam & Eve), and shall be**

joined unto his wife, and they two shall be one flesh (Christ in you). 32 This is the GREAT MYSTERY; but I speak concerning Christ and the church.
