

#26 YOUTUBE CONVERSION WITH AN APOSTATE BABE

The video was entitled "Are we watching bible prophecy unfold in real time?"

Here is my first post that I made on the video:

Dear Sir:

The book of Revelation & end-time prophecy are about the spiritual revealing of Christ that occurs when an elect person is converted. It is not about outward world events that only happen near the literal end of this age. None of those supposed outward events will happen. The book of Revelation teaches the SPIRITUAL events that occur within an elect person that will lead them to their moment of conversion. John also says that the book is not sealed and that the time for the fulfillment of the prophecy was already "at hand" (happening now). The book also says several times that the coming of Christ is a reoccurring event (is, was and will be coming). Christ's second coming is a reoccurring event because it happens within the life of each elect person before they die. Because of this truth, the second coming of Christ has been happening over and over again since the time John received the vision. The book also says that those who are blessed (the elect) will keep the sayings of the book - and that certainly includes all the bad sayings like becoming a man of sin and having the indwelling of the spirit of anti-Christ. If the prophecy is only fulfilled near the literal end of this age, how can any of the "blessed" have kept the sayings before they died? They couldn't have.

A poster responded to my post:

Dear Joe

It is both spiritual AND physical. Just as the prophecies about Jesus' life, triumphal entry into Jerusalem etc. were fulfilled physically, even to the EXACT day, so will the prophecies about physically resurrected Jesus Christ's second coming to Earth. His physical feet will touch down on the Mount of Olives!

The Holy Spirit shows us this:

"2Pe 3:3, Knowing this first, that there shall come in the last days scoffers, walking after their own lusts, 2Pe 3:4, And saying, Where is the promise of his coming? for since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as they were from the beginning of the creation. 2Pe 3:5, For this they willingly are ignorant of, that by the word of God the heavens were of old, and the earth standing out of the water and in the water: 2Pe 3:6, Whereby the world that then was, being overflowed with water, perished: 2Pe 3:7, But the heavens and the earth, which are now, by the same word are kept in store, reserved unto fire against the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men." John said the fulfillment was already "at hand" because it had started already. It's like dominoes that have started to fall but there are still some more waiting to fall.

The Old Covenant is the natural (physical). The prophecies that were fulfilled during the times of the Old Covenant were fulfilled physically by Christ and they led Him to the cross. The New Covenant is spiritual. Those prophecies are being fulfilled spiritually by Christ and those events happen WITHIN the elect. There are no outward physical fulfillments of prophecy left to fulfill. That ended when the Old Covenant ended. This division between the Old and New Covenants is what is meant when we are told to rightly divide the Word. Also, in the verse from Peter you quoted, Peter mentions Noah's flood in relation to the coming of Christ. Peter mentions it just as Christ did in Mat 24:37-41. Why does Christ and Peter both mention Noah's flood? They do so because it is the natural (physical) that comes before the spiritual. The spiritual that comes second is being fulfilled by the conversion process the elect will experience before they die. The spiritual events that lead an elect person to their moment of conversion is what end-time prophecy and Revelation teaches. During that process, Christ spiritually appears (called the second coming) to the person. After Christ appears, Christ will immediately begin the Day of the Lord (judgment) to remove the "chaff" (all the spiritual things that has made the person carnally minded & sinful) from within the person. They are "taken" and cast into the Lake of Fire. After Christ's judgment is complete, the person is converted and is now spiritually dwelling in the Kingdom of Heaven (represents their new spiritual state of being).

Dear Joe,

I know what you mean, that's why I said it is BOTH. You are missing something. God's redemption is not only of the spiritual but of the physical too (the physical body and the physical earth).

The belief that the redemption is only spiritual is similar to falling for the gnostic heresy that Christ was only resurrected and raised spiritually and not physically. You are limiting God's power of redemption through the blood of Jesus Christ to only the spiritual when that is not the case.

I almost fell for that myself. A few cults teach it too. If you examine the root of that belief, there is the spirit of Antichrist and/or some idolatry involved.

Also rightly dividing the word was something specifically taught by Paul, wasn't it, and Paul had a new gospel, as it were, a new dispensation given to him by the Lord to teach. It was different from what Peter was teaching, so the rightly dividing can't have been between Old (physical) and New (spiritual) as Peter was in the "New" -- so it was about time periods too. This is also

why the requirements for salvation change again after the rapture of the church and during the time of "Jacob's Trouble" -- i.e. believers need to not worship the Beast or take his mark etc.

For the elect, their resurrection will be in a spiritual body like the one Christ displayed. It will be able to be felt but it will also be able to pass through walls. It will not be anything like the physical bodies mankind has at present. As for the earth, nothing is taught in scripture about the earth being redeemed. The New Heaven and the New Earth are spirit words that relate to the celestial analogy used by Christ to teach spiritual truths. The New Earth represents a converted person's new spirit that has a divine nature. It is the spiritual that comes second. The natural earth that comes first represents mankind's marred and carnal spirit that they have now. The New Heaven represents Christ (Sun), the New Covenant (moon) and the angels of God (stars). The natural heaven represents Satan (sun), the Old Covenant (moon) and the fallen angels (stars). Dear Joe,

By saying "For the elect, their resurrection will be in a spiritual body like the one Christ displayed" you've confirmed you believe in the gnostic heresy that Christ's resurrection was only spiritual, in a spiritual body. Your understanding is violating the concept of first comes the natural, then comes the spiritual.

Paul said:

1Cor 15:44 "It is sown a natural body; it is raised a spiritual body. There is a natural body, and there is a spiritual body".

That statement couldn't be any clearer. Jesus was raised in a spiritual body that took on the appearance of his physical body so that the spiritually blind babes (the apostles) could recognize Him.

Next, I do not limit Christ's redemption of mankind. Christ was sent by the Father to save the world (1John 4:14) and He most certainly will not fail in that mission. If He did, that would be a sin. By the end of the final age, Christ will have saved (converted) every man, woman and child who has ever lived. No one will be lost (1Tim 2:3-6),

Concerning your question on the elect: In this age, Christ is only saving those persons who have been chosen from the foundation of the world (the elect/first fruits). They will be His Bride and will reign with Him in the final age to help bring in the final and great harvest of mankind. Christ is NOT working to save anyone else at this time.

As for how Christ saves a person, the pathway to salvation for an elect person begins when Christ spiritually comes to them and gives them a small measure of the Holy Spirit (Early Rain). Christ gives the person this gift without their asking for it and without their permission. Paul received the Early Rain on the Damascus Rd. This is when Paul became a spiritually blind, carnally minded and unconverted babe. In this condition, Paul (like all babes do) came under Satan's deceptions and fell away from faith. That is what occurred during his three days in Damascus. After the three days were complete, Christ came to Paul a second time (the second coming) and poured out the Latter Rain (the baptism). That is when the scales fell from Paul's eyes and is when Christ spiritually appeared to Christ (Heb 9:28). This is also when the man of sin is revealed to Paul and when Paul saw the Abomination of Desolation that previously occurred within himself (God's temple). Though not shown in Paul's conversion testimony,

Christ would have then began the Day of the Lord (judgment) within Paul to spiritually purify him (Mat 24:37-31 & Rev 19:11-21). After this judgment was complete, Paul was converted and dwelling in the Kingdom of Heaven. This pathway that Paul travelled to his salvation is the same pathway (1Tim 1:16) that all the elect will travel to their salvation. To cause it to happen, Christ will do 100% of the necessary work. The person contributes nothing. This is the true Gospel of Grace through Faith.

The false gospel of Satan mixes works with faith. It is the crooked way and that is why Satan is called the crooked serpent. When a person believes that they made a free will decision to accept Christ at the time of their own choosing, they are mixing their own works with faith. The truth is Christ is the one who caused the person to accept Him because Christ came to them by His own choosing and gave them the Early Rain. Dear Joe,

You've clarified you deny Jesus' second PHYSICAL coming, deny everlasting torment in the afterlife and deny salvation of through faith alone in the BLOOD atonement of Jesus Christ (which Paul, Jesus' chosen apostle to the gentiles was very clear about too, Rom [3:25](#)).

On one hand you say a gospel of grace through faith exists, but on the other hand you say Christ does all the work and comes to us and saves us without giving us a choice because he chooses the elect. You've got so many things mixed up and have resorted to believing heresies to make some sense of your confusion.

No man can call Jesus "Lord" but by having the Holy Spirit. If Christ didn't come to a person FIRST and give them the Early Rain, they would NEVER accept Jesus as Lord. Also, scripture teaches that mankind does not have a free will ability: Prv 16:1, Prv 20:24, Jer 10:23 and many others testify to this truth.

On the Damascus Road, Paul was traveling to persecute Christians in Damascus. What changed Paul's mind? Christ changed it by coming to Paul and giving Paul a small measure of the Holy Spirit. With the Holy Spirit, Paul could no longer call Jesus accursed but did as all mankind will do and that is to call Jesus "Lord" (1Cor 12:3). Here is where Paul confessed Jesus as Lord on the Damascus Road: Acts 9:6 6 And he trembling and astonished said, Lord, what wilt thou have me to do? Clearly, Paul was given the Early Rain and became a babe in Christ. Unless Christ comes a person and changes their heart and mind with the Holy Spirit, they would stay an unbeliever until they die. They have no free will ability to decide differently.

The Old Covenant is founded upon the works of man to be acceptable to God. The New Covenant is founded upon the works of Christ for a person to be acceptable to God. When a babe mixes the crooked way with the straight way, they will fall from grace. Since Paul's death, all the babes in the church (even up to today) will commit this sin. Why? Because Satan's crooked way is very appealing to mankind's carnal nature - in other words, the crooked way just seems right to them.

These verses apply:

Prov 16:25 There is a way that seems right unto a man, but the end thereof are the ways of death.

Luke 5:39 No man also having drunk old wine straightway desires the new: for he says, The old is better.

From what you stated in your post, I can tell that you are still following the crooked way. No babe can avoid this time of great tribulation as a man of sin. I was no exception. For an apostate babe to be restored to faith, Christ must come again with the Latter Rain. After Christ baptizes the babe with the Holy Spirit, their spiritual blindness will be healed and Christ will appear to complete the babe's conversion. This happens solely by the choice and works of Christ. The person has no say in the matter. By the end of the final age, Christ will have converted all mankind into the children of God. All the children of the Devil will then be perished. No one can stop Christ from completing the work that the Father gave Him. You do not believe these two scriptures:

Job 23:13 But he is in one mind, and who can turn him? And what his soul desires, that will he do.

Rom 5:18 so then as it was by one offence towards all men to condemnation, so by one righteousness towards all men for justification of life. 19 For as indeed by the disobedience of the one man the many have been constituted sinners, so also by the obedience of the one the many will be constituted righteous.

I recommend that you do as Luke 11:9-13 says. Then, if you are one of the elect (a "son"), Christ will come to you a second time and give you the Latter Rain.

Dear Joe,

You are cutting words out of scripture to fit in with your beliefs. It is not "righteousness towards all men" but the "free gift came upon all men"

Rom 5:18, Therefore as by the offence of one judgment came upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of one the free gift came upon all men unto justification of life.

The free gift, accepted upon believing, can be refused, as Jesus himself said:

Joh 3:18 He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. Joh 3:36 He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him.

Also:

Joh 5:22, For the Father judgeth no man, but hath committed all judgment unto the Son: Joh 5:23, That all men should honour the Son, even as they honour the Father. He that honoureth not the Son honoureth not the Father which hath sent him. Joh 5:24, Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and

shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life. Joh 5:25, Verily, verily, I say unto you, The hour is coming, and now is, when the dead shall hear the voice of the Son of God: and they that hear shall live. Joh 5:26, For as the Father hath life in himself; so hath he given to the Son to have life in himself; Joh 5:27, And hath given him authority to execute judgment also, because he is the Son of man. Joh 5:28, Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall hear his voice, Joh 5:29, And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation.

Rev 19:20 And the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast, and them that worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.

Rev 20:10 And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.

Rev 20:15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.

If ALL are saved in the end, as you say, why are the False Prophet, the Beast and the Devil in the Lake of Fire, tormented for ever and ever?

Why is there any need of judgement by the Son (John chapter 5) if ALL are saved, as you say?

Why, according to you, is the resurrection to life everlasting and the resurrection of damnation, temporary, when the Greek words used for both resurrection are exactly the same (John 5:29)?

Dear M_____,

The free gift is the Holy Spirit. It CANNOT be rejected. In fact, the person doesn't even know when they are given the gift because it cannot be seen with human eyes (comes without observation). However, the gift can be known to the receiver when it causes a confession of faith after they hear the gospel. Here is the order: the gift of the Holy Spirit is given, the person hears the gospel, faith comes by hearing it and the result is a confession of faith.

As for this verse:

Joh 3:18 He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

When a person sins, they become a child of the Devil. The child of the Devil cannot believe because they are void of the baptism of the Holy Spirit which gives them faith. As a result, they

are condemned already by their sins. Their fate is to perish in the Lake of Fire. The person's only hope is to be made into a new creation before they perish. The process of birthing a new child of God and destroying the child of the Devil is called CONVERSION. Conversion is greatly misunderstood by the apostate church. Every person of mankind is a child of the Devil because all have sinned. As a result, all mankind will perish in the Lake of Fire. But before anyone perishes from Christ's judgment, Christ will convert them into a child of God who is not condemned. This is how Christ saves mankind and satisfies justice at the same time.

As for the beast (an apostate babe), the false prophet (the spirit of anti-Christ) and the Devil being cast into the Lake of Fire, their fate is to be tormented and to be destroyed. But before this happens, Christ will have MERCY upon them and give them the Holy Spirit. With the Holy Spirit, they will have FAITH and be converted. The newly born child of God will be gathered to heaven. The beast, false prophet and the Devil will remain in the Lake of Fire to perish. This satisfies justice.

The verse below applies to how Christ judges the lost in the Lake of Fire. FYI, the Lake of Fire is a spirit word that means judgment. It is not literal fire.

Mat 23:23 Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye pay tithe of mint and anise and cummin, and have omitted the weightier matters of the law: JUSTICE, MERCY, AND FAITH: these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone.

And this verse:

Mat 5:44 But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you; 45 That ye may be the children of your Father which is in heaven: for he maketh his sun (Christ is the Sun) to rise on the evil and on the good, and sendeth rain (the Early and Latter Rain) on the just and on the unjust.

You asked:

Why is there any need of judgement by the Son (John chapter 5) if ALL are saved, as you say?

Judgment is necessary to satisfy the penalty of the law for sin which is death. Judgment is also necessary to remove the spiritual chaff within a person so that their mind will be transformed into the mind of Christ which does not sin. Judgment is a necessary component of man's salvation.

You asked:

Why, according to you, is the resurrection to life everlasting and the resurrection of damnation, temporary, when the Greek words used for both resurrection are exactly the same (John 5:29)?

Both are everlasting. The child of God lives forever and the child of the Devil perishes in the Lake of Fire (judgment). The problem you are having is that you do not understand conversion.

Here is a short verse on conversion:

Jer 18:4 And the vessel that he made of clay was marred in the hand of the potter: so he made it again another vessel, as seemed good to the potter to make it.

Mankind was purposely created spiritually marred by God. This flaw causes mankind to develop a carnal mind that sins. God planned and caused mankind to be sinful because He desires that all His new children have a knowledge of good and evil. The knowledge of evil comes first, then comes the knowledge of good. To convert a person, Christ will create the new vessel first, followed by the destruction of the old vessel. For the elect, they will be born as a child of God BEFORE their time of judgment commences. For the lost in the final age (most of mankind), their judgment will commence while they remain a child of the Devil. In this way, the lost in the final age will experience torment during their time of judgment, whereas, the elect will not. However, all will be converted prior to the child of the Devil's destruction.

Dear Joe,

You say this: "As for the beast (an apostate babe), the false prophet (the spirit of anti-Christ) and the Devil being cast into the Lake of Fire, their fate is to be tormented and to be destroyed."

This is FALSE, according to Rev 20:10, where God says their fate is to be tormented FOR EVER AND EVER.

Then you say: "But before this happens, Christ will have MERCY upon them and give them the Holy Spirit. With the Holy Spirit, they will have FAITH and be converted. The newly born child of God will be gathered to heaven. The beast, false prophet and the Devil will remain in the Lake of Fire to perish. This satisfies justice."

Can you not see the illogical position of this? You end up with 2 unbiblical possibilities: Either a never ending loop: 1) beast, false prophet + devil --> converted child of God gathered to heaven. 2) beast, false prophet + devil remain. 3) Repeat steps 1) and 2) forever, birthing converted child of God ad infinitum until someone arbitrarily decides they've been tormented enough and they perish. Or you are completely going against what God says in Rev 20:10: "... and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever." None of them perish. They remain there for ever and ever. Nothing in the Bible says they receive the Holy Spirit, that they perish etc.

Secondly, you also forget this, that blasphemy of the Holy Spirit and the danger of it was warned as a possibility: "Mar 3:28, Verily I say unto you, All sins shall be forgiven unto the sons of men,

and blasphemies wherewith soever they shall blaspheme: Mar 3:29, But he that shall blaspheme against the Holy Ghost hath never forgiveness, but is in danger of eternal damnation:"

Your CARNAL nature is reading into AND adding things in the Bible which are just not there for several reasons. 1) idolatry of self, blinding you to what the bible actually says and/or 2) you are channeling false "revelation" and being misled by demons happy to mix lies with some truth.

Thanks to the Holy Spirit and the Bible (as well as anointed biblical teachers), I've been delivered from the confusion behind universalism, Calvinism and Preterism. It's clear you're quite stubbornly holding onto your private interpretation despite what the Bible actually says. I'm familiar with where that goes and the reasons behind it so I've done my best to warn you.

The Greek phrase "aion aion" is commonly mistranslated. It should be translated as "for the age of the ages". The penalty of sin is death (Eze 18:4) and is not being tormented forever and ever in the Lake of Fire.

The correct translation of "aion aion" is easily proven by what Paul says below:

1Cor 15: 25 For he must reign, till he hath put all enemies under his feet. 26 The last enemy that shall be destroyed is death.

Paul says that Christ's reign will come to an end after Christ defeats death. However, this statement is contradicted by the verse below when it translates "aion aion" as for ever and ever.

Rev 11:15 And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he shall reign for ever and ever.

So is Paul wrong about Christ's reign coming to an end someday or is the common translation of "aion aion" incorrect?

The translations of scripture are NOT God inspired and they contain many errors. The KJV has been revised over 1000 times over the centuries.
